

# PRE-CIVIL WAR PULASKI COUNTY MAP!



This Civil War era map is believed to have been surveyed before the Civil War broke out. It was published in 1867 and shows the route the railroad had originally wanted to take. The tracks never took this route because of extensive tunnelling that made the proposed route too expensive. The Frisco Railroad eventually took a more northern route and allowed the cities of Dixon, Crocker and Richland to be born.
